PERSONAL TIME

(After arriving in Mornese the participants are free until lunch.)



PRAYER

(Mother Mazzarello's room is prepared with a vase, candle and the books to be distributed.)

Guide 1: We came here to ask for the love of God, to touch with our hands the fruitfulness of a life that has reached universal dimensions and has followed a fruitful path for more than 150 years.

We are here in the land of our origins: Mornese, gift of life! Here Mother Mazzarello took root; in the hands of God, it was a fertile ground in which the seed of the Word and the Eucharist bore much fruit.



In celebrating this moment of prayer, we too want to draw from the Source, to bring into our lives the flavor of this land - generous and strong, the taste of a land that is, the life of Mother Mazzarello.

Psalm 87 "All my sources are in you"

Guide 2: Today we begin our Mornese itinerary from this place where Maìn began her life journey. We returned to Mornese, to the sources, to our spiritual homeland. Here the "spirit of Mornese", which characterizes our Institute, was born; here all the FMA of every generation and all of us were born.

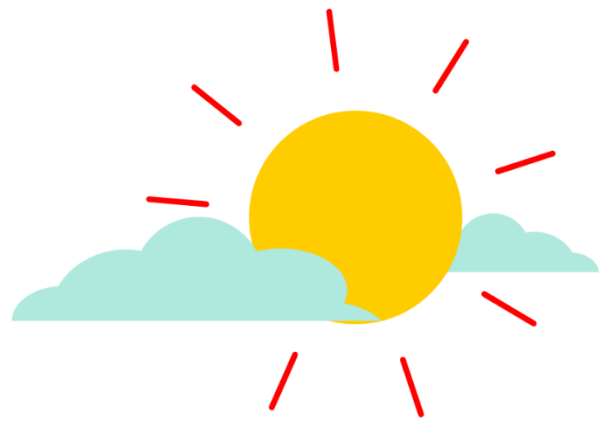

Guide 1: Looking at Maria Domenica we see a woman of relationships. From her simple and kind presence, confidence in her beliefs and flexibility in her forms, she was able to generate collaboration and involvement in view of the educational mission that the Lord has entrusted to her. Coordination for communion, which our Formation Program talks about, is a coordination that promotes vocational unity and convergence around the mission.

Deep down in the human heart there is always a longing to return to the root of one's identity in order to be able to recognize oneself in the flow of events and

things. There is an inalienable desire to have strong points of reference on earth, to be home: there is nostalgia for a homeland.

Psalm 87 “All my sources are in you”

Guide 2: Psalm 87 with which we will pray expresses in an intense and luminous way the pride and joy of belonging to the land given by the Lord with love, a land where the Lord himself lives.

Guide 1: The Psalm is divided into 3 parts: The first part of the psalm presents the psalmist who exalts God's relationship of predilection towards Zion.

Voice 1:

Its foundations are on the holy mountains;
The Lord loves the gates of Zion
more than all the mansions of Jacob.
Wonderful things are said about you,
City of God.

Guide 2: The second part contains words from God about Zion. It lets us imagine a census scene in which God himself welcomes the people who come to be registered. The Lord grants citizenship in his city to everyone.

Voice 2:

I will remember Rahab and Babylon
among those who know me;
behold, Palestine, Tyre, and Ethiopia:
everyone was born there.

Guide 1: The third brings the joyful singing of the peoples. Once in the city of God the people will begin a celebration with dance and songs. They note with admiration and amazement that each of them was born in Zion. As God's people, let us pray together.

*It will be said of Zion: "The one and the other were
born in it and the Most High holds it fast."
The Lord will write in the book of the peoples:
"He was born there".
And while dancing they will sing:
"All my sources are in you".*

Guide 2: Jerusalem... Mornese... The return with the heart to the "native land" is a strengthening of one's identity, a reinsertion into the space full of genuine affection, drawing from the past, and hope for the future. With a grateful heart let's say together:

*We have the eyes of our minds and hearts turned to Mornese.
This town is so small, this house is nothing,
yet for us, it is still the center of life.
(Fr. Costamagna)*

Guide 1: Mother Mazzarello reminds us, even today, that our presence will generate life if it is rooted in the presence of God who surrounds us and teaches us to listen, to walk together, to have a big and generous heart.

To the first missionaries, Mother Mazzarello wrote: "Conserve as much as possible the spirit of union with God, live continuously in his presence". Living in this PRESENCE is the true interior school that shapes the heart. It is a source of patience, humility, and listening; it is wisdom that opens up discernment to decipher the signs of God in reality; it is the secret of love in reciprocity and is the source of missionary audacity.
