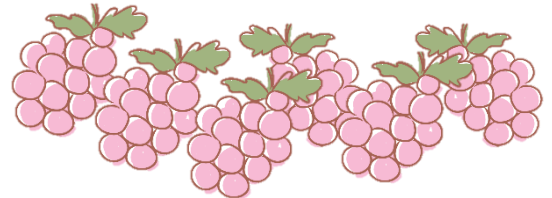

Entrustment *(alternating sides)*

Guide: We entrust our life to Mary, our Mother and guide so that she can help us to joyfully sing of God's love for us, to live our vocation with commitment, renewed in faith, in love with Jesus, eager to communicate with passion and coherence the beauty of the Gospel to the new generations:

O Mary Help of Christians,
we entrust our journey to you
of total donation to God.
Teach us to sing with joy and gratitude
our Magnificat to the Lord.

Make us attentive to the voice of the Spirit
so that we may know how to live with humility,
charity, simplicity, and trust in our daily life.
Like You, we desire to abandon ourselves to the Father
to continue to live chaste, poor, and obedient

and to be, with our life
transparency of God's love
and reflection of your maternal goodness
on the example of Mother Mazzarello
for the young people entrusted to us. Amen.

MASS

(Prepare a space before the altar where a "world heart" and pair of sandals or backpack will be placed at the end of the below introduction.)

Introduction *before Mass*

Guide 1: Today we remember the words of Pope Francis: "Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus (...). If we are not convinced, let's look at the first disciples, who immediately after knowing the gaze of Jesus, went to proclaim it full of joy: "We have met the Messiah" (*Jn 1:41*). Even Saint Paul, starting from his encounter with Jesus Christ, "immediately announced that Jesus is the son of God" (*Acts 9:20*). And what are we waiting for? (*EG 120*)

Guide 2: Let's now look at Mornese... the missionary fire enflames hearts! Even girls want to be missionaries!

September 1877. Don Bosco announced a little while ago that this time the FMA would also leave. They had to ask in writing and be ready!

Finally, here are the names: Sister Angela Vallese, Sister Giovanna Borgna, Sister Angela Denegri, Sister Teresina Mazzarello, Sister Angela Cassulo, Sister Teresa Gedda...

(Each participant will say her name aloud. The guide will continue after all names have been said.)

Guide 1: Together let us say:

All: We want to leave our mark with a missionary heart.

(The "world heart" and pair of sandals or backpack are brought to the altar.)

PRAYER

“Enlarge Your Tent” (Is. 54,2)

Voice 1: The Lord tells us: “Enlarge the space of your tent,

Voice 2: Spread the sheets of your dwelling without sparing,

Voice 3: Extend the cords, strengthen your stakes, for you will spread to the right and to the left and your descendants will possess the nations, they will populate the once deserted cities.

All: Do not be afraid.” *(Is 54:2)*

Guide 1: In the synodal path of the Church, we are called, as the people of God, to live the diversity of vocations and charisms in synergy. *(CG XXIV, 35.2)*

Guide 2: Inspired by the community of "Mornese in outreach" and in communion with the synodal path of the Church, we are invited to live our missionary vocation with joy.

Guide 1: We are here, close to his painting, which arrived in Mornese in February 1872, even before the Daughters of the Immaculate came to live at the Collegio. She, the Mother, preceded the Daughters. Since then, it has always been like this.



Voice 4: Petronilla recalls: "The first large image of the Madonna venerated in Valdocco entered our house quietly; and so as not to arouse the wasps, which never ceased to sting poor Fr. Pestarino and us too, with equal silence it was placed in the chapel of the Collegio under construction. I remember her in a false window, on the right, going towards the altar of the chapel; it was beautiful and represented the Madonna along with the Child Jesus. We immediately welcomed it as a sign of intimate joy and with our thoughts and hearts we hope for a favorable opportunity for Don Bosco's plans". Fr. Campi adds: "It was a painting in a kind of niche..." (*Cron. I 280-281*)

Guide 2: Under the gaze of this image of the Help of Christians, the Institute was born and accompanied the first community; It also seems time for us to be born again with renewed missionary ardor.

Guide 1: Looking at the image in silence, let us transport ourselves to those times. Let us imagine Sisters and girls in front of her, perhaps discerning their own vocation, let us be looked at, renewed by Mary's gaze, let us entrust our missionary vocation to Her today.

Guide 2: Today we want, in a special way, to thank the Father with Mary, for having called us, like the first Sisters of Mornese, to announce the Kingdom in the footsteps of Christ, in our own and unique way, leaving our Salesian imprint in an original way among young people.

Guide 1: Through the intercession of Mary Help of Christians, we ask for the fire of the Spirit of Jesus, the only one capable of igniting true missionary ardour and the greatest joy in our hearts.

Chorus 1: Virgin and Mother Mary, you who, moved by the Spirit, welcomed the Word of life, in the depths of your humility, faith, totally given to the Eternal, help us to say our "yes" in the urgency, more commanding than ever, to make the Good News of Jesus resound.

Chorus 2: Obtain for us now a new ardor of the resurrected, to bring to everyone the Gospel of life that conquers death. Give us the holy audacity to seek new ways to reach the gift of beauty that never fades.

Chorus 1: Star of the new evangelization, help us to shine in the testimony of communion, of service, of ardent and generous faith, of justice and love towards the poor so that, the joy of the Gospel reaches the ends of the earth and no periphery is deprived of its light.



All: Mother of the living Gospel, source of joy for the little ones, pray for us. Amen

(In the meeting room of Collegio 5-6 expedition groups will be created. Each group will be assigned one of the missionaries from the first expedition. The missionary assigned to them will be the protagonist in the skit.)

(In the meeting room of the Collegio, each group will take turns presenting their missionary expedition.)



PRAYER

(In the room of Mother Mazzarello distribute the “world hearts” to each participant. On a small table place a writing pen, ink pad and moist wipes to clean hands. A place is created to leave the hearts on the floor during the dynamic.)

Church Outgoing

Guide 1: We are in the midst of this living space, where the charismatic dynamism of our Institute is represented within the Church. We walked seeking the encounter with God in our experience.

We meet to "Give first place to God" like our first Sisters of Mornese, willing to prefer "the good of others to their own" (*Const. Art. 50*); they were willing to courageously GO OUT to meet others.



Guide 2: Let's listen to Pope Francis who told us: "Let's dare a little more to take the initiative! As a consequence, the Church knows how to "get involved". Jesus washed his disciples' feet. The Lord involves himself and his own, kneeling before others to wash them. But immediately afterwards he says to the disciples: "You will be blessed if you do this" (*Jn 13:17*). The evangelizing community places itself through works and gestures in the daily lives of others, shortens distances, stoops to the point of humiliation if necessary, and takes on human life, touching the suffering flesh of Christ in the people. The evangelizers thus have the "smell of the sheep" and listen to their voice". (*EG, 24*)

Guide 1: Mother Mazzarello is here with us; Let's listen to what she tells us: In letter no. 5 addressed to the General Director Fr. Giovanni Cagliero.

5 April 1876

Long live Jesus! in Italy, in America and throughout the world!

Rev. Father Provincial,

What a pleasure to be able to spend some time with our good Father! Oh! how many things we would like to tell you! But when the heart is full, one does not know where to start.

Did you receive the letter I wrote to you at the beginning of this year? I hope so although you didn't answer.

Therefore, tell the Jesus who is in America that he gives us all the virtues necessary to be good religious, especially humility and obedience, do with us what he wants, but do not allow any Sister, especially if professed, to lay down the habit and leave the House of Mary.

Now that I have given you news of the house, I will write to you the names of those who wish to go to America soon: I would like to be there already, the Mother Vicar, the Mother Bursar, Sr Mina, Sr Maria Belletti, Sr Giuseppina, Sr Giovanna, Sr Emilia (really), sr... I couldn't stop if I said the names of all those who wish to go there. So quickly prepare a little place for us too, and then come and get us since we don't know how to go there alone, and it could also happen that since we are alone, some sea monster, who hasn't had lunch yet, uses us to satisfy his appetite.

Each Sister would like to tell you many things but so as not to waste so much of your time reading, I end by asking you for a particular blessing for each of us, and recommending myself in a special way to your prayers which, I assure you, I need it greatly now that the number of daughters is increasing, increasing every day.

Bless me therefore and believe me to be your humble daughter in J.[esus]

Guide 2: With the experience we have had, contemplating and praying about the missionary itinerary of our Institute, let us prepare to revive our missionary identity like Mary, let us remember the many situations of our brothers and sisters, especially those from the peripheries of all the continents.

We respond after each spontaneous prayer:

"Help of Christians, help our imprint be like Jesus' imprint."



All: We too, like our first missionary Sisters, every time we are ready to "go out", we will discover our Mother with us, guiding each one in particular, to once again recommend the courage to sail the seas, to go out to the peripheries, especially to young people, in total abandonment to God who always precedes us.



(As the song plays each participant will approach the table, write their name on the back of a heart, and with the ink pad leave her imprint on the world. The heart is then left on the prepared area close to the table. The song will repeat until all have accomplished this task.)
