Guide: We are walking in Don Bosco's footsteps to retrace his human, Christian, and spiritual growth itinerary. We will visit Turin, Becchi, Colle, Chieri, Valdocco, and the Basilica of Mary Help of Christians. Don Bosco gives each of us a personal message. Let us open our hearts to what the places reveal to us.

Jn 2,1-11 Wedding Feast at Cana

On the third day, a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." "Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come." His mother told the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water,"; so they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." They did so, and the master of the banquet tasted the water turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom and said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now. What

Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory and his disciples believed in him.

Guide: The first miracle performed by Jesus Christ during his ministry is the transformation of water into wine at a wedding feast of Cana, through the intervention of Mary.

The joyous and festive atmosphere of the wedding banquet is symbolized by wine. The absence of wine causes uneasiness among the guests. If there is a lack of wine, there is a lack of joy; the touch of wine gives quality and flavor to life and makes one creative, courageous, and resourceful. But, among the guests, there is the Mother of Jesus. She has a heart that sees and foresees. God blesses us. Today, as pilgrims on a journey, we are invited to enjoy God's presence and the company of others.

(Each participant receives a shoe-symbol)

Guide: As a symbolic gesture, we receive a shoe that reminds us that we are pilgrims on a journey in search of God, who reveals himself in the signs of the times in our everyday life. We receive this shoe in the spirit of hope recalling Pope Francis' words in this Jubilee Year, that hope is both a gift from God and a task for all Christians – “the breaking through of the possible into the impossible” (*Pope Francis, 6 November 2024*). Don Bosco's whole life mirrors such hope!

Let us implore Mary's guidance so that she can enable us to establish a relevant and steadfast relationship with reality so that the revelation of Jesus intertwines with our history. Thus, the prophetic dimension of our lives not only proclaims the spirit of the Gospel but also makes it visible in us today.
